The organizing authority is the Kansai Yacht Club (KYC)

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

## 1 RULES

- 1.1 Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2021-2024 (RRS), including Appendix D (Team Racing Rules).
- 1.2 RRS D2 (Umpired Races) apply.
- 1.3 RRS D1.1(b) is changed by replacing "two hull length" with "three hull lengths".
- 1.4 Appendix G (identification on Sails) will not apply.
- 1.5 The International Dragon Class Rules shall apply.
- 1.6 No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.7 If there is a conflict between languages English text will take precedence.
- 1.8 In the event of conflict between any of the rules and regulations, other than RRS, then the Sailing Instructions will prevail. This changes RRS 63.7.

#### 2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available from 15th September 2023 at the KYC Office.
- 2.2 Any change in the Sailing Instructions shall be posted on the Official Notice Board by 1700 hours on Friday 15th September 2023 and signaled as per RRS Race Signals. The Official Regatta Notice Board is located at KYC "Wet Bar".

## 3 [DP] COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at http://kyc.or.jp/.
- 3.2 From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

#### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 The Regatta is open to invited teams only. Entry shall be restricted to members of the following clubs: the Royal Sydney Yacht Squadron (RSYS), the Royal Vancouver Yacht Club (RVYC), the Royal Hong Kong Yacht Club (RHKYC) and the Kansai Yacht Club (KYC).

- 4.2 Each Club entry shall consist of a team of three (3) boats. Rotation of skippers and/or crews during the Interport is allowed.
- 4.3 To remain eligible, each crew must complete registration prior to obtaining access to any boat and a damage deposit of **JYEN 100,000.00** shall be paid by each team to the KYC. In the event that a deduction is made from a deposit, the team from whose deposit the deduction was made shall restore the deposit to the original value.
- 4.4 Eligible clubs may enter by completing the entry to the KYC office by 1700 hours Monday 26th June 2023.
- 4.5 This Regatta will be held when three or more clubs including the Kansai Yacht Club apply.

# 9.2 Type of Racing

- 9.2.1 This Interport shall consist of team races.
- 9.2.2 The format of the race will be one or more full Round-Robin followed by Knock-out.
- 9.2.3 One Round-Robin shall be completed to constitute the Interport.

# 10 [DP] CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

10.1 Each competitor shall wear a personal flotation device, at all times while on the water, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. This changes RRS 40 and the preamble to RRS Part 4. PFDs shall be worn outside of all clothing.

## 11 VENUE

- 11.1 NoR Attachment A of 'Location of Kansai Yacht Club" shows the plan of the event venue.
- 11.2 NoR Attachment B of" Racing Area" shows the location of the racing areas.

## 12 COURSES

12.1 The course will be as determined by the Race Committee and as described in the Sailing instructions.

#### 13 PENALTY SYSTEM

13.1 RRS D1.3 (Penalties) will apply.

#### 14 SCORING

14.1 RRS D3 and D4 will apply. Each race will be scored as provided in RRS D3 and the series will be scored as provided in RRS D4.

## 15 [DP] BOATS

- 15.1 The Interport will be sailed in International Dragon Class boats, kindly provided by their respective owners for competitors, who shall not modify them or cause them to be modified in any way except that:
  - 15.1.1 a compass may be tied or taped to the hull or spars;
  - 15.1.2 wind indicators, including yarn or thread, may be tied or taped anywhere on the boat;

- 15.1.3 hulls, centerboards and rudders may be cleaned, but only with water;
- 15.1.4 adhesive tape may be used anywhere above the water line;
- 15.1.5 all fittings or equipment designed to be adjusted may be adjusted, provided that the class rules are complied with.
- 15.1.6 running repairs can be made provided the boat is not permanently affected by these repairs.
- 15.2 No spinnaker will be provided by the organizing authority. Own Spinnakers shall be brought by each team.
- 15.3 The red flag for protesting will be provided by the race committee for each boat.

# 16 [DP] BERTHING

16.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while in the harbor.

## 17 [DP] HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

17.1 Boat shall not be hauled out during the event except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

#### 18 [DP] DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

18.1 Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the event.

## 19 [DP] DATA PROTECTION

19.1 The organizing authority may require competitors to be available for interviews. The organizing authority shall have the right to use at any date or time, free of any charge, any images, sound or footage recorded during the event. The use of drones to record in anyplace by non-affiliated persons is prohibited. Any recording by persons concerned shall be declared to the organizing authority in advance and permission shall be obtained.

#### 20 RISK STATEMENT

- 20.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 20.2 All those taking part in these races do so at their own risk and responsibility. Specific attention is drawn to RRS 4 which states; continue racing is hers alone". The KYC, sponsors, any Class Association, the Race Committee and other race officials are not responsible for any damage or injury either afloat or ashore.

## 21 REGATTA OFFICE

21.1 The Regatta Office will be the KYC Office.


